EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Capitol Interactive Exhibits and Wayfinding Subcommittee (Subcommittee) met to receive updates on the Capitol Kiosks, Civics Lab, Four Sisters maquettes, and bollard installation.

CALL TO ORDER

Co-Chairman Racines called the meeting to order at 8:15 AM. The following sections summarize the Subcommittee proceedings by topic. Please refer to [Appendix 1-01](#) to review the Subcommittee Meeting Agenda. The meeting is available on the [Wyoming Legislature's YouTube page](#).

CAPITOL KIOSK UPDATE

Jacob Schneider, Senior Interactive Producer, Dimensional Innovations, highlighted new information on the Capitol Kiosks which included the digital maps, which match the printed maps throughout the Capitol Square. The kiosk interactive maps will assist people to get to their next location in the Capitol Square. The informational kiosks are placed throughout the Capitol and Capitol Extension.

CIVICS LAB UPDATE

Ashley Bonderer, Project Manager, Dimensional Innovations, provided an update on the Civics Lab preparation ([Appendix 3-01](#)). Ms. Bonderer stated carpet installation is complete, and the wall graphics will be completed next. Ms. Bonderer shared fabrication images of the furniture builds, technology interactive builds, and the constitution station elements ([Appendix 3-01](#)). Nigel Morely, Creative Director, Dimensional Innovations, described the company's industrial shop in Kansas City.

Digital Interactives

Meg Conley, Senior UI/UX Designer, Mr. Morley, Mr. Schneider, Dimensional Innovations, provided updates on the developments of the interactives throughout the Civics Lab. Ms. Conley discussed the design for the welcome video for guests engaging with the interactive exhibits ([Appendix 3-01](#)). There are planned welcome videos for the following:

- The Constitution Station's Welcome Interactive;
- The Constitution Station's Constitution Interactives;
- The Consider All Sides Interactive;
- The Executive Station's Elected Officials Desk;
- The Checks & Balances Interactive;

Emilio Servigon, Creative Director, Dimensional Innovations, provided more details on the Constitution Interactive attract video that will focus on Articles 1 through 5 of the Wyoming Constitution with simplified interpretations of Constitutional provisions ([Appendix 3-01](#)).

Ms. Conley then provided a status update of the Citizen Station interactive exhibit. The Government Impacts You drive interactive held within the Citizen Station is currently in development. Next, Ms. Conley shared updates on the Legislative Portraits Interactive preview that provides short biographical information of Wyoming's citizen legislators. Six former legislators were chosen for this interactive and the legislators' families will assist Dimensional Innovations in sharing the information. Ms. Conley reviewed the Consider All Sides Interactive which allows visitors to listen to public testimony and cast a vote like a legislator in a committee meeting. There was discussion by the Subcommittee to include Native American people as one of the characters ([Appendix 3-01](#)).

Ms. Conley reviewed the Elected Officials Interactive attract loop which would include facts about five Statewide elected officials both inside and outside of their government role. Mr. Schneider discussed the Powers at Play Station Interactive, and the belt system used to turn the gears that represent how the branches of government work together.

Ms. Conley described the final piece to the Civics Lab update on the Checks and Balances Interactive that is in development. The interactive explains the three branches of government and how they interact with one another. The Subcommittee discussed how the visitor passport used for the Civics Lab applies to this experience. The passport gives visitors an opportunity to remember visiting the Civic Labs.

Ms. Conley provided updates on the physical samples of the vault door prototype used in the Civics Lab ([Appendix 3-01](#)).

Review Graphic Panel Printouts, Student Path Installation, and Carpet Installation

The Subcommittee completed a walking tour of the Civics Lab. The Subcommittee reviewed physical samples of the Civics Lab interactives. The Subcommittee provided feedback on modified digital activations from the Civics Lab for students who can't travel to the Capitol. The modified digital activations being developed are similar to what is offered by the judicial branch at the Judicial Learning Center. The Subcommittee reviewed the possibility of providing virtual tours for students who cannot travel to the Capitol.

FOUR SISTERS MAQUETTES

Kevin Ramler, Director, Wyoming State Museum, reviewed the direction provided by the Subcommittee to purchase the existing artist-proof maquettes of the Four Sisters statues. Mr. Ramler indicated the Subcommittee has yet to decide whether to purchase additional maquettes or determine the quantity and size of producing additional maquettes. The maquettes for the molds no longer exist. If the Subcommittee wanted to create new maquettes, the Subcommittee would need to create new molds. The Subcommittee discussed the opportunities and challenges with the reproduction and selling of additional maquettes. There was discussion by the Subcommittee on pricing and purchasing options on additional sizing of the maquettes. Co-Chairman Landen moved that the Subcommittee purchase the artist-proof maquettes of the Four Sisters statues and negotiate the price prior to purchase. The motion passed.

BOLLARD INSTALLATION UPDATE

Brandon VanTassell, Project Manager, State Construction Department, Construction Management Division noted that the bollards are currently in development. The Division finished pouring the curbs and gutters near the bollards. The Division will finish the installation of the Capitol bollards within the week and then work will begin on installing bollards for the Supreme Court. The bollard installation for both projects will be completed by the beginning of 2026.

PUBLIC COMMENT

No public comment was provided.

OTHER MEETINGS AND ADJOURNMENT

Co-Chairman Racines reminded the Subcommittee of the next meeting date of December 16, 2025. There being no further business, Co-Chairman Racines adjourned the meeting at 9:52 AM.
