for

- 1 AN ACT relating to state lands; removing the restriction on the number of authorized good neighbor authority employee 2 positions; requiring employee positions to be funded only 3 using funds from the Wyoming state forestry good neighbor 4 5 authority revolving account; authorizing gifts, donations 6 and bequests to be deposited into the account; prohibiting 7 the acceptance of real property for purposes of the good 8 neighbor authority; and providing for an effective date.

1 **Section 1**. W.S. 36-1-502 and 36-1-503(a) by creating a 2 new paragraph (vi) and (b) are amended to read: 3 4 36-1-502. Wyoming state forestry good neighbor 5 authority revolving account; creation; investment of funds; authorized expenditures. 6 7 8 There is created the Wyoming state forestry good neighbor authority revolving account. The account shall 9 10 include all legislative appropriations, federal funds, county funds, partner funds, funds generated from good 11 12 neighbor authority projects or other federally funded 13 cooperative forest management projects, grants, gifts, transfers, bequests, donations and all 14 income from 15 investments of monies in the account. The state forester is 16 specifically empowered to accept grants, gifts, transfers, 17 bequests and donations for deposit in the account, 18 including those which are limited in their purpose by the 19 grantor except as provided in W.S. 36-1-503(a)(vi). If a 20 contract is entered into pursuant to W.S. 36-1-503(a)(iii), 21 funds in the account may be expanded on good neighbor

30 The state forester may hire additional employees (b) as necessary to conduct good neighbor authority projects or 31 32 other federally funded cooperative forest management 33 projects funded through the account. Employees hired under 34 this subsection shall be funded using federal funds 35 deposited in the account. The state forester shall not fill more than four (4) full-time employee positions and six (6) 36

at-will employee contract positions under this subsection.
