- 10 (c) is amended to read:
- 22-6-130. Post-election ballot audit.

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1	(c) The county clerk shall notify the county chairman
2	of each political party having a candidate on the ballot and
3	all independent candidates of the time and place of the audit
4	required under this section. Not less than two (2) electors
5	in the county, who shall be representatives of different
6	political parties, shall be present during the audit to
7	observe the audit procedures and the results of the audit.
8	Additional political party representatives and
9	representatives of independent candidates may be present
10	while the audit is conducted. If an insufficient number of
11	representatives are available as required under this
12	subsection, the county clerk may appoint one (1) or more
13	representatives of different political parties as necessary
14	to meet the audit observation requirements of this
15	subsection. Representatives observing the audit under this
16	section shall be given the opportunity to register any
17	observed errors or other objections to the audit with the
18	county clerk and the county clerk shall provide those
19	registered statements, and any response to the statements, to
20	the secretary of state at the time the audit results are
21	submitted under subsection (b) of this section.
