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12 This draft legislation appropriates \$395,472,358 for K-12 13 school facilities based upon the School Facilities 14 Commission's (Commission) recommended budget for the State 15 FY 2027-2028 biennium, approved at the Commission's July 16 23-24, 2025 meeting.

Please note, the draft legislation does not include the FY 2027-2028 funding for: 1) the operation of the State Construction Department (Department) and Commission; engineering and technical costs; and 3) major maintenance. These amounts are traditionally appropriated in the general government appropriations bill through agency 027 - State Construction Department. The Commission recommends \$235,054,719 for major maintenance costs. Standard budget amounts for the operating costs of the Department and Commission and for engineering and technical costs were not identified in the recommended budget, but are forthcoming. The Commission's recommended budget includes \$758,685 of exception requests for operation of the Department:

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- Computers and software: \$29,361;
- Funding for one full-time employee (FTE) position for a senior policy and planning advisor: \$373,459;
- Funding for one FTE position for a finance and analytics manager: \$276,944;
- Travel: \$78,921.

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Wyoming Statute 21-15-117(a) and 21-15-119(a) requires the Commission submit prioritized lists of specific projects based on condition and capacity. With the exception of component projects, the Commission's recommended budget does not include prioritized schedules and does not identify whether a project qualifies for a remedy based on condition or capacity. As such, prioritized designations are not included in this bill draft, but placeholders remain. The Commission will provide this information prior to the Committee meeting and upon Committee approval, the designations will be added in subsequent drafts.

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Wyoming Statute 21-15-119(c) requires the Commission's budget submission to specify design and construction amounts for each project. The Commission identified amounts by project for design, construction, demolition, and component projects in an alternative document submitted to the LSO. The budget submission does not specify amounts for charter school and modular leases by project and school district.

The Department requested specific amounts for each project 1 not be included in this bill draft. As a result, this version of the draft bill does not include specific amounts for any project, but the placeholders remain. This is policy decision for the Committee and the Legislature. 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STAFF COMMENT

LSO recommends the Committee consider a provision to govern the allocation of funds in subparagraph (j)(viii)(A) of this section if the funds are insufficient to pay the total amount requested by school districts through the application process. The options include award on a first come, first served basis, or pro rata reduction with a date specific for application.

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LSO also recommends the Committee consider requiring the Commission to adopt rules to govern the application requirements, award process, and notification of school districts. The following language is an example of language for the Committee's consideration:

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36 37 Application for a grant under this subparagraph shall be on a form and in a manner specified by school facilities ο£ the commission. Applications shall be filed with the construction department on or before August 1, 2026, and August 1, 2027, for the immediately succeeding school year. Not later than August 15, 2026, for school year 2026-2027, and August 15, 2027, for school year 2027-2028, the department shall notify school districts in writing of the commission's decision to award or funds. Ιf an application is denied, the
