- 15 hundred thousand dollars (\$31,900,000.00) from the public
- 16 school foundation program account to the state construction
- 17 department for major maintenance payments to school
- 18 districts made necessary by the amendments enacted in
- 19 section 1 of this act. This appropriation shall be for the
- 20 period beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June 30, 2028.
- 21 This appropriation shall not be transferred or expended for
- 22 any other purpose and any unexpended, unobligated funds

5 hundred thousand dollars (\$11,800,000.00) from the public

6 school foundation program account to the department of

7 education-school finance for routine maintenance payments

8 to school districts made necessary by the amendments

9 enacted in section 1 of this act. This appropriation shall

10 be for the period beginning July 1, 2026 and ending June

11 30, 2028. This appropriation shall not be transferred or

12 expended for any other purpose and any unexpended,

13 unobligated funds remaining from this appropriation shall

14 revert as provided by law on June 30, 2028.

16 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon

17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

19 Constitution.
