A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to K-12 physical education requirements;
2 requiring the state board of education to establish minimum
3 instructional time requirements for physical education;
4 requiring school districts to adopt a policy prohibiting
5 removal of students from physical education for
6 disciplinary purposes; and providing for an effective date.

8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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10 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-2-304(b) (xviii) and 21-3-110(a) by
11 creating a new paragraph (xlvi) are amended to read:

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13 **21-2-304. Duties of the state board of education.**

2 (b) In addition to subsection (a) of this section and
3 any other duties assigned to it by law, the state board
4 shall:

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6 (xviii) Not later than July 1, 2027, adopt a
7 model policy that school districts may utilize establishing
8 minimum instructional time requirements for student
9 participation in physical education courses.

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11 **21-3-110. Duties of boards of trustees.**

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13 (a) The board of trustees in each school district
14 shall:

15

16 (xlvii) Not later than July 1, 2027, adopt a
17 policy prohibiting the removal of a student from physical
18 education courses for disciplinary purposes, except when the
19 disciplinary action is directly related to the student's
20 conduct in a physical education course.

22 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
23 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

1 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
2 Constitution.
