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WYOMING TEEN DRIVER ACCIDENTS

The following tables and charts depict accidents in Wyoming involving teen drivers ages 14-20 in 2011 (tables 1 through 3) and 2012 (tables 4 through 6). Specifically, the first table for each year depicts the type of accident involving a teen driver, the second table shows the condition of the driver, the third table breaks down accidents with teen drivers by city/town and the final table shows accidents involving teen drivers in each county.

Drivers age 14-20 were involved in 22.8% of the 14,794 total accidents in Wyoming in 2011 and 21.6% of the 13,893 total accidents in 2012. It should be noted that the total number of accidents within a year may vary from table to table due to the fact that different criteria were used in creating each table.
