LOVE SWORN IN TO REPRESENT SENATE DISTRICT 06; SENATE COMMITTEE CHANGES ANNOUNCED

CHEYENNE – Taft Love of Cheyenne was sworn in as a member of the 68th Wyoming Legislature on Tuesday in the Senate Chamber of the Wyoming State Capitol in Cheyenne. Wyoming Supreme Court Justice Bridget Hill administered the oath of office and President of the Senate Bo Biteman presided over the ceremony.

Following the administration of the oath of office from Justice Hill, President Biteman and fellow Senators welcomed Sen. Love to the Wyoming Legislature. Love briefly addressed those in attendance saying, “I look forward to serving all the residence in Senate District 6 and I will always be available for you. My servant’s heart is filled today.”

The Laramie and Platte County Commissioners appointed Love at a special meeting on Aug. 29 to fill the vacant seat formerly held by Sen. Darin Smith, who resigned from his seat on Aug. 11. Love will serve Senate District 6 through Jan. 4, 2027.

Additionally, President Biteman announced the following committee changes to fill vacancies upon Sen. Smith’s resignation and Sen. Eric Barlow stepping down as Chairman of the Senate Labor, Health & Social Services Committee:

- Sen. Evie Brennan has been appointed to serve as Chairman of the Senate Labor, Health & Social Services Committee;
- Sen. Bob Ide has been appointed to serve as Chairman of the Senate Agriculture, State and Public Lands & Water Resources Committee;
- Sen. Tim French has been appointed the Senate Appropriations Committee;
- Sen. Eric Barlow has been appointed to the Senate Transportation, Highways & Military Affairs Committee;
- Sen. Ogden Driskill has been appointed to the Select Water Committee.
