CREATION

The Legislative Service Office was created by an Act of the Forty-First Legislature, Chapter 113, Session Laws of Wyoming 1971. It commenced operations on March 1, 1971. The Office provides research and bill drafting services for legislative standing or interim committees and for individual legislators, including pre-filing and distribution of proposed legislation prior to legislative sessions; revision and recompilation of the laws of Wyoming; preparation of copy and contracting for the printing and publishing of all revisions, compilations, session laws, journals and digests; and accounting for all legislative expenditures, supplies and properties. In addition, members of the office staff prepare administrative rule reviews and reports for the Management Council, conduct program evaluations of executive agencies under the direction of the Management Audit Committee, and conduct fiscal studies and budget analysis for the Joint Appropriations Committee and other legislative committees.

Policies, rules and regulations governing general operations of the Office and its relationship to legislative standing committees and individual legislators are made by a Management Council composed of thirteen legislators – six members from each house and one member elected at large.

The Director is employed by and subject to the direction of the Management Council. The Director with the approval of the Management Council employs LSO employees.

MEETING PAYMENTS BY LEGISLATOR INTERIM MEETINGS – 2010

The following apply to the information contained in this list:

1. This list contains mileage, per diem and salary payments to legislators for participation in official legislative interim work. Official legislative interim work consists of meetings of interim and select committees of the legislature, plus other authorized legislative meetings. Beginning in 2009, legislators are also compensated ½ salary for preparation for each day an interim committee meets. In addition, legislators are compensated ½ salary for travel to and/or from an interim committee meeting. Travel salary is not paid for travel occurring on a day the member receives salary for the committee meeting.
2. Note that the number of meetings attended by a legislator is primarily a function of two factors: the number of committees to which that legislator has been appointed and the number of meetings during an interim that a committee meets. Some legislators are appointed to several committees while some may serve on only one committee. Due to the scope of committee workload during an interim, some committees may meet only for a day or two while others meet several times.
3. The Management Council at the conclusion of each session approves interim committee study topics and budgets for meetings. Committees may not exceed those budgets without Council approval.
4. Salary and per diem payments for interim meetings held in a legislator's hometown or of short duration, e.g. a compressed video meeting, may be at a reduced level in accordance with Management Council policy as reflected in the Legislative Handbook.
5. This list does not contain payments to legislators for salary, per diem and mileage related to general, budget or special sessions of the Legislature. Legislators, who live outside Cheyenne, receive payment for round trip mileage to and from the session plus per diem for travel days to and from the session. All legislators receive salary and per diem for each day from convening to adjournment of each session. Legislators living outside Cheyenne are entitled to be reimbursed for mileage for one trip each week should they travel home.

1. This list contains travel and per diem payments (actual expenses) to legislators for out of state travel on official legislative business. The Legislature participates in several organizations such as the National Conference of State Legislatures (NCSL), The Energy Council, the Council of State Governments (CSG), etc. The presiding officers appoint legislators to committees of these organizations. Any legislator may attend without prior approval of the Speaker and President a maximum of two out of state meetings per year subject to availability of budget. Travel in excess of the two authorized meetings would require Management Council approval.
2. Most out of state travel involves legislators who have been appointed to committees of organizations in which the Legislature participates.
3. The Management Council must approve any out of state travel to a meeting outside the continental United States (lower 48).
4. Legislators receive reimbursement for actual expenses associated with authorized out of state travel, subject to limitations contained in Management Council travel policies. Legislators receive no salary when engaged in authorized out of state travel.

JOINT JUDICIARY INTERIM COMMITTEE

Priority #: 1 Wind Energy Rights

Issues related to property rights, dominance of estates and severance of estates in the development of wind energy are becoming increasingly important in Wyoming. The Committee proposes to consider these issues and possibly develop legislation for consideration for the 2011 General Session.

Priority #: 2 Court Ordered Placements of Juveniles

The Department of Family Services is required to conduct a study of child caring facilities and the process for determining placement of juveniles in the custody of the Department pursuant to 2010 House Bill 0001. Although the resulting report is not required to be submitted to the Joint Judiciary Interim Committee and the Joint Appropriations Committee until July 1, 2011, the Joint Judiciary Interim Committee proposes to consider the role of courts in the placement of juveniles during the 2010 interim and will request interim updates on the progress of the DFS study, including consideration of any legislation that may be developed for the 2011 General Session.

Priority #: 3 Parole Options

The new medium security prison in Torrington has opened and is being rapidly filled, due in part to the fact that Wyoming has a higher rate of incarceration than many other states. To address the increasing pressures created by a growing prison population, the Committee is proposing to review alternatives to current parole procedures to alleviate some of those pressures. Such alternatives may include proposing legislation to authorize short-term return to prison for treatment, authorizing street time credit for time spent on the sentence while on probation or parole and authorizing home incarceration for certain types of offenders.

Priority #: 4 Streamlined Court Procedures for Claims Below a Specified Amount

Current trends in pretrial discovery have made the cost of pursuing claims prohibitive for many claimants to the point that the cost of pretrial discovery may equal or exceed the damages sought. To address this issue, the Committee would like to study what other states have done to limit pretrial discovery and depositions to enable people to have quicker and lower cost access to the courts when damages sought do not exceed a specified amount to be determined.

Priority #: 5 Sex Offender Restrictions

If 2010 House Bill 0083, Crimes and offenses-restrictions for adult sex offenders, is not enacted into law, the Committee would propose studying what other states are doing with respect to restrictions on sex offenders who live in the community and the consequences of those restrictions to determine what may best work for the citizens of Wyoming.

Priority #: 6 Miscellaneous Reports

The Committee will be receiving a number of reports in the 2010 interim, including reports from: The Department of Corrections, relating to sex offender management techniques; the Victim Services Division, relating to provider reporting requirements; the Attorney General, relating to compliance with SORNA (the Adam Walsh Act); the Department of Transportation, relating to the issue of drivers canceling vehicle insurance policies after registering a vehicle; and, from sheriffs, relating to progress on meeting new requirements for juvenile detention facilities. These reports may propose or require legislative action.

SELECT COMMITTEE ON SCHOOL FACILITIES

Priority #: 1 School Facilities Commission Reorganization.

Pursuant to Budget Bill Section 341, the Select Committee is required to prepare a reorganization plan for the School Facilities Commission for submission to the Joint Appropriations Committee. The plan is to be submitted to JAC by September 1, together with enabling legislation, and is to include all components of the school capital construction system.

Priority #: 2 School Facilities Commission budget and school facility remedies.

The Select Committee is by law required to review the School Facilities Commission budget on school facilities needs, and to review monthly reports depicting all school capital construction projects and component level projects funded and forwarded in the 2011-2012 budget. Any resulting budget recommendations are to be submitted to the Joint Appropriations Committee by September 1.

Priority #: 3 School Capital Construction System Process.

Following through with 2009 audit findings on the School Facilities Commission, ensure the facility prioritization process and the scheduling of facility construction projects reflect legislative intent, with specific attention devoted to the impact of facility capacity on appropriately "sizing" facilities and responding to changing school populations, as well as the relationship of facility needs identification criteria and the subsequent determination of facility remedies. An additional factor in this review is the role of major maintenance in addressing facility needs.

Priority #: 4 School Facilities Commission Post-Audit.

Pursuant to Budget Bill Section 340 and following up on the 2009 audit findings, the Department of Audit is required to conduct an accounting of total costs of all school capital construction projects funded for the preceding four biennia ending with the most recent 2009-2010 biennium. The accounting is to be reported to the Select Committee by September 1, in conjunction with the Commission's supplemental budget request.
