




Latest data reveal little relationship between recent changes in rates



















Comparison of Average Sentence Length and Average Length of Stay







TWO APPROACHES - Similar Goals

- Build Additional Beds
 - Improve Public Safety (continue low crime)
 - Hold Offenders
 Accountable
 (appropriately punish criminal behavior)
 - Continue Growth of Institutional Costs
 - New Construction Costs
 - New and Ongoing Operating Costs
 - Collateral Costs

- **Expand Alternatives**
 - Improve Public Safety (continue low crime)
 - Hold Offenders
 Accountable
 (appropriately punish criminal behavior)
 - Control Corrections Costs
 - Maintain/Reduce Prison Bed Space Needs
 - Invest in Options with Lower per Offender Costs
 - Reduce Collateral Costs
